655th TRANSPORTATION COMPANY

Constituted 17 February 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 786th Quartermaster Company

Activated 7 March 1942 at Orlando, Florida

Reorganized and redesignated 19 September 1942 as the 1974th Quartermaster Truck Company, Aviation

Inactivated 31 December 1945 in Germany

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 1974th Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 2 March 1948 as the 655th Transportation Truck Company and concurrently allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 15 March 1948 at Columbus, Ohio

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 3 November 1949 at Columbus, Ohio

Redesignated 7 March 1950 as the 655th Transportation Heavy Truck Company

Activated 1 April 1950 at Opp, Alabama

Ordered into active military service 11 September 1950 at Opp, Alabama

655th TRANSPORTATION COMPANY

Reorganized and redesignated 5 June 1953 as the 655th Transportation Company

Released from active military service 3 December 1954 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 20 April 1955 to Tuskegee, Alabama; on 25 March 1957 to Montgomery, Alabama

Inactivated 1 July 1958 at Montgomery, Alabama

Activated 16 October 1997 at Millington, Tennessee

Ordered into active military service 7 December 2003 at Millington, Tennessee; released from active military service 15 April 2005 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 22 August 2005 at Millington, Tennessee; released from active military service 17 February 2007 and reverted to reserve status


