Reorganized and redesignated 19 December 1943 as the 3483d Quartermaster Truck Company

Inactivated 5 October 1945 in Italy

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3483d Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 6 March 1947 as the 68th Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 19 May 1947 as the 68th Transportation Truck Company

Activated 20 June 1947 in Germany

Reorganized and redesignated 2 December 1949 as the 68th Transportation Heavy Truck Company

Reorganized and redesignated 5 June 1953 as the 68th Transportation Company
