Redesignated 6 March 1947 as the 69th Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 19 May 1947 as the 69th Transportation Truck Company

Activated 20 June 1947 in Germany

Redesignated 15 January 1950 as the 69th Transportation Heavy Truck Company

Reorganized and redesignated 5 June 1953 as the 69th Transportation Company


