Constituted 17 February 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 783d Quartermaster Company

Activated 13 March 1942 at Will Rogers Field, Oklahoma

Reorganized and redesignated 13 September 1942 as the 1971st Quartermaster Truck Company, Aviation

Inactivated 6 November 1945 at Hill Field, Ogden, Utah

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 1971st Transportation Corps Truck Company (Aviation)

Redesignated 20 April 1948 as the 706th Transportation Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 3 May 1948 at Bellefontaine, Ohio

Location changed 13 February 1950 at St. Marys, Ohio

Inactivated 9 August 1950 at St. Marys, Ohio

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 24 November 1967 as the 706th Transportation Company

Activated 22 January 1968 at Mansfield, Ohio

Ordered into active military service 4 February 1991 at Mansfield, Ohio; released from active military service 18 June 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 7 December 2003 at Mansfield, Ohio; released from active military service 3 June 2005 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 15 September 2006 at Mansfield, Ohio


