Constituted 1 July 1936 in the Organized Reserves as Company A, 476th Quartermaster Regiment

Redesignated 1 April 1942 as Company A, 476th Quartermaster Truck Regiment

Ordered into active military service 31 March 1943 and organized at Camp McCoy, Wisconsin

Reorganized and redesignated 17 November 1943 as the 3801st Quartermaster Truck Company

Inactivated 31 December 1945 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3801st Transportation Corps Truck Company

Activated 1 November 1946 at Colorado Springs, Colorado

Redesignated 14 October 1947 as the 3801st Transportation Truck Company

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 3 June 1948 as the 709th Transportation Truck Company

Location changed 19 July 1949 to Salida, Colorado

Inactivated 15 April 1952 at Salida, Colorado

Redesignated 1 August 1952 as the 709th Transportation Heavy Truck Company
