Ordered into active military service 31 March 1943 and organized at Camp McCoy, Wisconsin

Reorganized and redesignated 17 November 1943 as the 3804th Quartermaster Truck Company

Inactivated 11 March 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3804th Transportation Corps Truck Company

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Activated 21 November 1946 at Denver, Colorado

Redesignated 14 October 1947 as the 3804th Transportation Truck Company

Redesignated 3 June 1948 as the 711th Transportation Truck Company
