Constituted 28 May 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 55th Quartermaster Truck Battalion

Consolidated 7 July 1943 with the 2639th Quartermaster Truck Battalion (Provisional) (organized 13 March 1943 in Algeria) and consolidated unit designated as the 55th Quartermaster Truck Battalion

Company C, 55th Quartermaster Truck Battalion reorganized and redesignated 19 December 1943 as the 3359th Quartermaster Truck Company (remainder of battalion hereafter separate lineages)

3359th Quartermaster Truck Company inactivated 6 April 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3359th Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 5 October 1948 as the 730th Transportation Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 29 October 1948 at Reno, Nevada

Reorganized and redesignated 13 June 1949 as the 730th Transportation Heavy Truck Company

Location changed 10 April 1950 to Fresno, California

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 20 May 1953 as the 730th Transportation Company

Inactivated 16 September 1980 at Fresno, California

Activated 16 September 2010 at Bell, California
