Constituted 8 November 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 2221st Quartermaster Truck Company, Aviation

Activated 20 January 1944 in England

Inactivated 31 December 1945 in France

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 2221st Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 12 August 1948 as the 733d Transportation Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 29 September 1948 at Chicago, Illinois

Reorganized and redesignated 23 March 1950 as the 733d Transportation Heavy Truck Company

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 10 April 1953 as the 733d Transportation Company

Location changed 12 July 1954 to Osage City, Kansas

Inactivated 15 March 1972 at Osage City, Kansas

Activated 16 June 1998 at Reading, Pennsylvania

Ordered into active military service 21 January 2003 at Reading, Pennsylvania; released from active military service 13 June 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 5 June 2009 at Reading, Pennsylvania; released from active military service 9 July 2010 and reverted to reserve status


