Constituted 17 February 1949 in the Organized Reserve Corps as the 737th Transportation Truck Company

Activated 15 March 1949 at Seattle, Washington

Reorganized and redesignated 15 September 1950 as the 737th Transportation Heavy Truck Company

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 20 May 1953 as the 737th Transportation Company

Location changed 1 February 1958 to Yakima, Washington

Ordered into active military service 13 May 1968 at Yakima, Washington; released from active military service 13 August 1969 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 7 December 2003 at Yakima, Washington; released from active military service 3 June 2005 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 3 May 2009 at Yakima, Washington; released from active military service 6 June 2010 and reverted to reserve status
