Inactivated 6 November 1945 at Ogden, Utah

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 1952d Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 1 March 1948 as the 743d Transportation Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 12 March 1948 at Newark, New Jersey

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 October 1950 as the 743d Transportation Heavy Truck Company

Inactivated 1 November 1950 at Newark, New Jersey

Redesignated 10 May 1955 as the 743d Transportation Company

Activated 7 September 1955 at Manchester, Vermont
