Reorganized and redesignated 10 April 1952 as the 762d Transportation Heavy Truck Company

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 20 May 1953 as the 762d Transportation Company

Ordered into active military service 17 November 1990 at Canton, Ohio; released from active military service 3 July 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 15 January 1994 to Akron, Ohio

Ordered into active military service 21 January 2003 at Akron, Ohio; released from active military service 15 July 2004 and reverted to reserve status
