Constituted 28 December 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 2077th Quartermaster Truck Company, Aviation

Activated 1 January 1943 at Baer Field, Indiana

Inactivated 9 November 1945 at Kelly Field, Texas

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 2077th Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 9 August 1948 as the 773d Transportation Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 24 August 1948 at New Haven, Connecticut

Reorganized and redesignated 5 October 1950 as the 773d Transportation Heavy Truck Company

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 20 April 1952 as the 773d Transportation Company

Location changed 29 August 1971 to Fairfield, Connecticut; in 1999 to Fort Totten, New York

Ordered into active military service 1 November 2002 at Fort Totten, New York; released from active military service 31 October 2003 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 16 January 2006 and 24 February 2006 at Fort Totten, New York; released from active military service 14 July 2007 and 22 August 2007 and reverted to reserve status
