Activated 7 April 1949 at Montgomery, Alabama

Inactivated 31 December 1950 at Montgomery, Alabama

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 22 August 1955 as the 824th Transportation Company

Activated 1 September 1955 at Beaufort, North Carolina

Location changed 1 March 1958 to Morehead City, North Carolina

Ordered into active military service 1 October 1961 at Morehead City, North Carolina; released from active military service 3 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Element ordered into active military service 1 November 2002 at Morehead City, North Carolina; remainder of company ordered into active military service 16 January 2003 at Morehead City, North Carolina

Element released from active military service 31 October 2003 and reverted to reserve status; remainder of company released from active military service 15 January 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Element ordered into active military service 23 January 2010 at Morehead City, North Carolina; released from active military service 21 July 2010 and reverted to reserve status
