Redesignated 19 May 1947 as the 89th Transportation Truck Company

Activated 20 June 1947 in Germany

Redesignated 15 January 1950 as the 89th Transportation Heavy Truck Company

Reorganized and redesignated 5 June 1953 as the 89th Transportation Company


