Constituted 30 July 1942 in the Army of the United States as Company C, 363d Quartermaster Battalion

Activated 8 August 1942 at Camp Edwards, Massachusetts

Reorganized and redesignated 25 May 1943 as the 693d Quartermaster Truck Company

Inactivated 15 May 1946 in Japan

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 693d Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 16 April 1947 as the 915th Transportation Corps Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 1 May 1947 at Jeffersonville, Indiana

Redesignated 13 October 1947 as the 915th Transportation Truck Company

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 17 November 1950 at Jeffersonville, Indiana

Redesignated 16 April 1959 as the 915th Transportation Company

Activated 1 May 1959 at Hammond, Indiana

Location changed 1 November 1960 to East Chicago, Indiana; on 31 January 1968 to Council Bluffs, Iowa

Ordered into active military service 27 September 1990 at Council Bluffs, Iowa; released from active military service 28 April 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 7 June 2004 at Council Bluffs, Iowa; released from active military service 3 December 2005 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 15 September 2006 at Council Bluffs, Iowa

Activated 16 September 2012 at Hiller, Pennsylvania

Location changed 15 December 2013 to Smithfield, Pennsylvania


