Inactivated 5 March 1946 in the Philippines

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3315th Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 16 April 1947 as the 919th Transportation Corps Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 7 May 1947 at Kalamazoo, Michigan

Redesignated 14 October 1947 as the 919th Transportation Truck Company

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 15 November 1950 at Kalamazoo, Michigan

Redesignated 21 March 1956 as the 919th Transportation Company and activated at Flint, Michigan
