Constituted 2 April 1945 in the Army of the United States as the 91st Quartermaster Car Platoon

Activated 19 May 1945 at Pilsen, Czechoslovakia

Inactivated 31 December 1946 at Bad Nauheim, Germany

Converted and redesignated 1 January 1947 as the 91st Transportation Corps Car Platoon

Redesignated 17 September 1947 as the 91st Transportation Car Detachment

Activated 13 October 1947 at Trieste, Italy

Inactivated 1 December 1949 at Trieste, Italy

Redesignated 22 April 1959 as the 91st Transportation Detachment and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 1 May 1959 at Buffalo, New York

Location changed 1 March 1960 to Tonawanda, New York

Inactivated 15 March 1972 at Tonawanda, New York

Activated 16 April 1984 at Hampton, Virginia

Ordered into active military service 27 August 1990 at Hampton, Virginia; released from active military service 18 June 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 1 November 1993 to Fort Eustis, Virginia

Ordered into active military service 2 February 2003 at Fort Eustis, Virginia; released from active military service 9 August 2004 and reverted to reserve status
