Constituted 31 July 1942 in the Army of the United States as Company A, 488th Port Battalion, Transportation Corps

Activated 15 December 1942 at Indiantown Gap Military Reservation, Pennsylvania

Reorganized and redesignated 30 June 1943 as the 188th Port Company

Inactivated 30 June 1946 at Naples, Italy

Redesignated 16 April 1947 as the 939th Port Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 24 April 1947 at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 13 October 1947 as the 939th Transportation Port Company

Reorganized and redesignated 18 February 1955 as the 939th Transportation Company

Location changed 30 July 1969 to Pedricktown, New Jersey

Inactivated 15 March 1972 at Pedricktown, New Jersey

Activated 16 September 2012 at Athens, Georgia

Location changed 21 January 2013 to Statham, Georgia
