- 3. Championing antitrust legislation/The Clayton Antitrust Act
- 4. Establishing the Federal Trade Commission
- 5. Passing the Child Labor Act
- 6. Passing the Workingmen's Compensation Act
- 7. Passing the Adamson Act

Regressive Polices

- 1. Segregated federal facilities (bathrooms, offices, cafeterias)
- 2. African Americans were assigned least desirable positions
- 3. African Americans were given inferior work spaces/conditions
- 4. Prohibition of interracial marriage
- 5. Political alignment with the Ku Klux Klan
- 6. Policies to limit economic competition of African Americans
- 7. Segregated Army
