




Colonel Henry Leavenworth and the soldiers of the 3rd Infantry Regiment crossed the Missouri River in 1827 to establish Cantonment Leavenworth. Little did they know their isolated outpost would one day become one of the United States Army's premier centers of higher education. The Frontier Army Museum with its unique blend of horse-drawn vehicles, weapons, uniforms, and equipment, combine to create a sense of the Frontier Army's role in the exploration and settlement of the West and expansion of Fort Leavenworth.


